The Fugal Operator is a key member of the Production Team at Broadwater Mill. Reporting to the shift supervisor, the role of the fugal operator is to plan, prioritise and monitor the fugal station processes.

The fugal station incorporates the HG & LG pan coolers and crystallisers, HG & LG fugals, sugar drier, re-melt system, sugar floor and sugar bins, and the magma, molasses and syrup systems.

The key function of the Fugal Operator is to process massecuites into sugars and syrups, to manage the quality of these products and monitor sugar floor operations.

In order to support organisational growth the fugal operator is expected to actively support and explore opportunities for continuous improvement projects to facilitate more efficient and safe operations and eliminate unproductive work practices.
